#### The Sign of the Cross

The Sign of the Cross in its external form is a declaration of our faith and our union with the crucified Christ, who is "the power of God and the wisdom of God" in the face of every weakness and foolishness (1 Corinthians 1:23-24). Thus we say, "Yes" in a visible and public manner to Christ who suffered in the flesh for us and manifested the love of God for us until the end, that we may declare with Him our acceptance of the cross of suffering and redemption in our private lives and profess our participation in the salvific love of God. And, we confirm, committed to the fact that God judges the world with the humility of suffering and love. For, in the appearance of weakness He is the All Powerful One, and in the appearance of impotence, He is able to save each one of us. With the Sign of the Cross, we place ourselves under His protection and under the capability of God and we march on the path of life in His footsteps in accordance with His call: "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me. (Mark 8:34)

**Relics of St. Charbel**. The relics of St. Charbel will be at St. Ann's on May 7 - 8. The relic which is coming is a **Class I relic** - taken from the body of Saint Charbel. Relics of Christian Saints fall into categories: the First Class Relic is the body or a portion of the body of a Saint (bone, flesh, or hair). These are considered so precious that they are rarely entrusted to individuals, and are placed in Faith Communities.

If you would like a keepsake of your visit, you can purchase a rosary in the Church and touch it to the Blessed Relic when you approach the altar. There will also be Holy cards and Blessed oil & incense available, for a small donation.
