#### **MARONITE LITURGY**

#### Worship & Kneeling

Worship is understood in the Bible according to the meaning of the Greek word *Proskynein*. When the disciples saw Jesus walking on the sea, He climbed into the boat, after lifting Peter to prevent him from drowning, "Those who were in the boat did him homage, saying, "Truly, you are the Son of God" (Matthew 14:33). The same thing happened with the man who was blind from birth. When Jesus met him, after healing him, He asked if the man believes in the Son of Man? The man inquired: "Who is he, sir, that I may believe in him?" Jesus said to him, "You have seen him and the one speaking with you is he." He said, "I do believe, Lord," and he worshiped him" (John 9:35-38).

Doing homage is an act of faith and worship before God, before Christ and before the Sacrament of the Eucharist. It is normally performed by kneeling before the exposed Blessed Sacrament and by kneeling when incensing the cross or the icon of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This kneeling is known in Hebrew as "*Barak*." Bending the knee, according to the tradition of the Old Testament, symbolizes bending our strength before the living God, confessing that all that we have, is a gift from Him. It is known that the knee, "*Berek*," signifies strength.

Gestures of spiritual worship express themselves through motions of the body, by doing homage or by kneeling. Without the bodily postures of spiritual worship, homage loses all its meaning and becomes simply an external act. True worship encompasses the human person in all his capacity...
