MARONITE LITURGY

The Work of Jesus and the Community

The ritual of the Mass consists of two services: The Service of the Word and the Service of the Eucharist. In each, Christ Himself, who is the Principal Leader, is at the head of the community of believers. He is the glorious High Priest who presides invisibly over every Eucharistic celebration, represented by the bishop or priest, and the presiding celebrant, as the people participate. Among them are lectors, altar servers, offerings bearers and cantors.

The **earthly Liturgy**, though performed at the hands of the priests, is presided over by Christ the Lord, through them. The Liturgy remains entirely the work of Christ present in His Word and the sacrifice of His Body. This includes the angels, saints, and people living and deceased, past, present and future, in a different form. The *Book of Revelation* from Saint John describes this, in a mystical way, as the **heavenly Liturgy**. It is the Liturgy of God - the feast of love and joy of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit that are consummated, and with which we are one, through the earthly Liturgy.




