*"When we walk without the Cross, when we build without the Cross, and when we profess Christ without the Cross, we are not disciples of the Lord. We are worldly: we are bishops, priests, cardinals, Popes, but not disciples of the Lord."*

## White Week - HAWAREYEEN

The season of Resurrection opens with the week that has been known by different names in the liturgy: Week of Resurrection, Easter Week, Week of Renewal, and last but not least, "Week of Weeks". However, the name most commonly applied to it is "Week of Hawareyeen". The word suggests the idea of "white" and "justification". It refers either to the angels at the empty tomb (who announced his resurrection, clothed in white), or to the Lord's disciples (who believed in his resurrection and thus, were clothed in "justification"), or also to the newly baptized members of the Church (clothed both in white at this time of the year and in justification through the baptismal waters).

**Wednesday** Apparition at the Sea of Tiberias: Peter's Mission  
**Thursday** Apparition on the Road to Emmaus  
**Friday** Apparition in the Upper Room: Greeting of Peace and Showing of Wounds  
**Saturday** Apparition in the Upper Room

## Divine Mercy Novena

Jesus asked that the Feast of the Divine Mercy be preceded by a Novena to the Divine Mercy which would begin on Good Friday. He gave St. Faustina an intention to pray for on each day of the Novena, saving for the last day the most difficult

intention of all, the lukewarm and indifferent of whom He said: *"These souls cause Me more suffering than any others; it was from such souls that My soul felt the most revulsion in the Garden of Olives. It was on their account that I said: 'My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass Me by.' The last hope of salvation for them is to flee to My Mercy."*

In her diary, St. Faustina wrote that Jesus told her:

"On each day of the novena you will bring to My heart a different group of souls and you will immerse them in this ocean of My mercy ... On each day you will beg My Father, on the strength of My passion, for the graces for these souls."

## Prayer of Divine Mercy Novena



*I fly to Your Mercy, Compassionate God, Who alone are good. Although my misery is great and my offenses are many, I trust in Your Mercy because You are the God of Mercy, and it has never been heard of in all ages, nor do Heaven or Earth remember, that a soul trusting in Your Mercy has been disappointed.*

(State your intentions)

*Jesus, Friend of a lonely heart, You are my haven.*

*You are my peace.*

*You are my salvation.*

*You are my serenity in moments of struggle and amidst an ocean of doubts.*  
*Amen*

The different souls prayed for on each day of the novena are:

DAY 1 (Good Friday)	All mankind, especially sinners
DAY 2 (Holy Saturday)	The souls of priests and religious
DAY 3 (Easter Sunday)	All devout and faithful souls
DAY 4 (Easter Monday)	Those who do not believe in Jesus and those who do not yet know Him
DAY 5 (Easter Tuesday)	The souls of separated brethren
DAY 6 (Easter Wednesday)	The meek and humble souls and the souls of children
DAY 7 (Easter Thursday)	The souls who especially venerate and glorify Jesus' mercy
DAY 8 (Easter Friday)	The souls who are detained in purgatory;
DAY 9 (Easter Saturday)	The souls who have become lukewarm.

During the Solemn Novena leading to Divine Mercy Sunday, the Chaplet of Divine Mercy should be offered each day for the day's intentions.

## Holy Saturday broadcast of Shroud

The Shroud, the burial cloth of Christ, bears a mysterious image of a man who suffered in a manner consistent with crucifixion. It is kept in the Cathedral of Saint John the Baptist in Turin, Italy, and is rarely available for viewing. The extremely limited access to seeing the shroud gives the TV broadcast particular significance. It will be shown internationally by the Italian public service broadcaster Rai 1. The Holy Saturday broadcast of the Shroud images is only the second-ever, with the other occurrence taking place in 1973.

## 2 Lebanese Youth Prepare Texts for Via Crucis in Colosseum

Under Cardinal Béchara Boutros Raï, patriarch of Antioch's guidance, 2 young people from Lebanon wrote the meditations for the Via Crucis of Good Friday, to be led by the Pope in the Colosseum of Rome.

The texts appeal for prayers for those who, imitating Pilate "use their authority in the service of injustice and trample on man's dignity and his right to life." For those who believe that they "can replace God and determine on their own what good and evil are, "doing this" in the name of reason, of power and of money." It also mentions the "blind secularism that suffocates the values of faith and morality in the name of an alleged defense of man," and the "violent fundamentalism which takes as pretext the defense of religious values."

Also the invitation to look at Christ who has identified himself with the weak, not forgetting because of this, the humiliated suffering peoples "in particular those of the martyred East, indicating that with Him they can carry their own cross of hope."

In the XII station, which recalls the death of Jesus on the Cross, life in Christ is exalted and an appeal is made to pray for those who promote abortion and euthanasia "so that they will be committed to building the civilization of life and love."

An appeal is also made to respect religious liberty so that "the different religions can come together to serve the common good and to contribute to the development of every person in building the society."

And in the women of Jerusalem they will see the women of today wounded in their dignity who suffer violence because of discriminations.

In Christ's three falls they recall the wounds of the division in the Church. And, in the Deposition of Jesus, is the great opening to hope especially for those who seek the meaning of life, so that they will believe that Christ conquered death and sin.



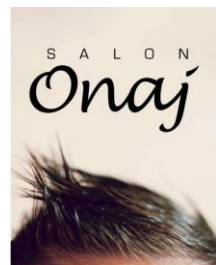
