MARONITE LITURGY

The Homily

The homily comes in to aid the faith-encounter with Jesus, the Word, as the Apostle Paul puts it: "Thus faith comes from what is heard, and what is heard comes through the word of Christ" (Romans 10:17). In his Apostolic Exhortation Evangelii Gaudium (The Joy of the Gospel), His Holiness, Pope Francis, stressed the importance of the homily, because God wants to reach out to others through the homily and to exercise His power through human utterance, to renew the faith of listeners and develop it. For the homily revives the dialogue that God started with the faithful through divine utterances, which they heard and which gives the Liturgy its meaning and the warmth of participation in it. His Holiness, the Pope, calls for the preparation of the homily through contemplation, prayer and openness to the inspirations of the Holy Spirit on the part of the priest, who has to firstly be renewed through the Word, so he can relay it to the faithful as a witness to life. When he prepares the homily, he has to invoke the efficacious and creative light of the Holy Spirit, making of himself and his capabilities an instrument of the work of the Spirit. to be continued




