MARONITE LITURGY

The Earthly Liturgy and Heavenly Liturgy

In the Sacrifice of the Mass, the work of our redemption is realized through the Divine Presence with us and in us through Jesus' Pascal Mystery. This is the mystery of His sacrifice for our salvation, and the banquet of His Body and Blood for our life. The Second Vatican Council's Constitution on Sacred Liturgy, Sacrosanctum Concilium, states: "At the Last Supper, on the night when He was betrayed, our Savior instituted the Eucharistic sacrifice of His Body and Blood. He did this to perpetuate the sacrifice of the cross through the centuries, until He returns. In so doing, He entrusted to His beloved spouse, the Church, a memorial of His death and resurrection: a sacrament of love, a sign of unity, a bond of charity, a paschal banquet in which Christ is consumed, the mind is filled with grace, and a pledge of future glory is given to us."

The word **Quddass** (**Mass**) means **Taqdees** (Consecrating), as the Lord Jesus prayed after blessing the bread and wine in His Eucharistic, Pascal Supper:

"And I consecrate myself for them, so that they also may be consecrated in truth" (*John* 17:19).

He consecrated Himself by making of himself a perfect sacrifice, thus becoming the intimate Pontiff and the sacrificial offering at the same time. He thus sanctified us through His death and resurrection.


