MARONITE LITURGY

Participation in the Divine Liturgy

Every time we participate in the Sacrifice of the Mass, we are living the event of our salvation, the mystery of the death of Christ and His resurrection. We are thanking God, the Father, for His love for us through His Son, Jesus, our Lord. We renew our love for Christ, the Lord; we participate spiritually in His death and resurrection; and we also sit at His Supper Table and hear Him saying, here and now:

"This is my body, which will be given for you; do this in memory of me...This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which will be shed for you" (*Luke* 22:19-20).

We are also **consecrated by the descent of the Holy Spirit,** for in a new Pentecost we declare three times with the priest celebrant:

"Hear us, O Lord, hear us, O Lord, hear us, O Lord. May your holy and living Spirit descend and overshadow us and our offering."

Lastly, we realize that we are celebrating the Host of love and reconciliation with God and with each other, and we hear the Lord saying to us:

"Go first and be reconciled with your brother, and then come and offer your gift" (*Matthew* 5:24).


