### MARONITE LITURGY

#### Harmony in the Roles and the Liturgical Cycle

Each liturgical celebration is a unique Liturgy insofar as the roles and actions of those assembled. To raise the community to the level of the celebration, which is both divine and human, **harmony** must be achieved **between all components and attendants**: celebrant, concelebrants, deacons, lectors, cantors, altar servers and the prayerful community. Prayers should be recited and readings proclaimed with clarity, reverence, faith and piety, for we are in the presence of God. In this regard, distinct **rubrics** are provided to distinguish the role and duty of each person in the celebration; thus, we pray the *Psalms* with a simple tune, chant the hymns with joy and devotion, and recite communal prayers in a tranquil manner, well ordered and clear.

In this spirit we should devote ourselves to devout liturgical actions so they may be received by all as prayerful expressions of the faith. This harmony is an outward expression of internal faith. Harmony should also encompass the assembled community, doing the same thing at the same time. .
