MARONITE LITURGY

Liturgical Formation

Proper formation is absolutely necessary in order to achieve an efficacious and solemn spiritual participation in the liturgical celebrations. It should encompass both clergy and laypeople and be made available in parishes, schools, formation centers for priests, monks and women religious, in theological colleges and institutes of religious formation. For that purpose, media and modern technological methods are to be employed commensurate with the recommendations of the Maronite Patriarchal Synod that considers "liturgical reform" as realized in the Church whenever two things come together:

- 1) Scientific formation and research on the Liturgy from the historical, theological and pastoral perspectives, and,
- 2) the ongoing formation of priests, seminarians, monks, women religious and the laity for the purpose of deepening liturgical understanding and ritual knowledge in their theological, spiritual and pastoral dimensions on the one hand, and on the other, to organize liturgical celebrations and invigorate them in the prayerful parish communities.


