MARONITE LITURGY

Mass of the Lord Jesus is our Mass

Jesus celebrated His first Mass after His resurrection with the two disciples of Emmaus (Luke 24:13-33). From that basis, our Mass came to exist, in its two services: the Service of the Word, and the Service of the Eucharist.

In the Service of the Word, the two disciples of Emmaus were listened as Jesus explained the Scriptures to them but their eyes were prevented from recognizing Him. He walked with them on the road and began to dispel their grief and strengthen their resolve and cement their faith through "what referred to him in all the scriptures". Each of them had a burning desire to know the truth about what happened to Jesus of Nazareth. They heard Him explain the Scriptures and apply them to the all events which had occupied their minds. Because of the immense attachment they had to Him, His words and explanations, they insisted He stay the night with them. He transformed their despair into hope, and when they recognized Him in the Breaking of the Bread, one of them said, "Were not our hearts burning within us while he spoke to us on the way and opened the scriptures to us?" (Luke 24:32).

He walked with them; explained the Scriptures; they listened to Him; He calmed their hearts with a touch of the Spirit...These are the actions of the Service of the Word in every Mass...


