MARONITE LITURGY

Service of the Word

Just as in the Lord's first Mass, the Service of the Word in the Maronite Divine Liturgy, begins with a longing of the heart for an encounter with Christ, our Teacher and the Savior. We desire to be enlightened by His words, that shed their light on our daily life, to strengthen our faith, provide hope and enflame in our hearts with love. The symbols for this enlightenment are manifested by the presence of one candle adjacent to the lectern during the reading of the Epistle and two for the Gospel. This symbolism can be traced back to the a line by the author of the Book of Psalms:

"Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light for my path"

(Psalm 119:105).

With the preparation of the offerings on the side altar, we offer up our very selves, our love for God and for each other, our good works, pains and worries, and the intentions of our prayers. With the priest, we enter the house of the Lord and bow our heads before the holy Throne, supporting each other in prayer. With Him, we begin the Service of the Word by making the Sign of the Cross for the glory of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, reciting the opening prayer of the day.


