#### **MARONITE LITURGY**

#### Service of the Eucharist

The Eucharistic prayer forms an integrated theological unit beginning with the Trinitarian Blessing: "The love of God, the Father..." and ending with the prayer: "O Lord, you are the pleasing Oblation...". This is the work of the One Triune God. In all its parts, it is the Holy of Holies of the Mass. Its structure is Trinitarian; It is a prayer of the divine plan. It celebrates the Father's memorial plan, described through the Eucharistic actions, charting the stages of the history of the plan of salvation beginning with creation. The Church offers thanksgiving to the Father for "the grace of creation, life and salvation," which He gave us after "Adam's fall." The Eucharistic prayer portrays the intervention of the Father for the salvation of mankind, and His intervention "in the fullness of time," when He sent His Only Begotten Son, "incarnate of the Holy Spirit and the Blessed Virgin Mary, thus, arranging all things for our salvation."

The Eucharistic prayer continues by describing the plan of the Son, particularly in "the words of consecration". Through it, our Lord says: "Take, eat of it all of you, this is my Body." "Take, drink from it all of you, this is my Blood." "Do this in remembrance of Me." This is the Word of the Lord, which reflects His will. It is the life giving Word. From it life springs forth, and in it is the transubstantiating power for the bread and wine to become the Body and Blood of Christ.

The offering of the Church continues and is consummated in every Eucharistic sacrifice between His first and His second coming. That is why the community asks the Father to send the Holy Spirit, consoling and advocating, consummating and sealing. And the commemorations of the living and the dead come to embody the reality of the Church in her sons and daughters called to this Eucharistic encounter, to become living members in the Body of Christ and witnesses to His resurrection.

### **Points of Interest**

**REMINDER:** Altar Bread, Wine & Sanctuary Lamp/ + Incense, Charcoal & Candles are now being reserved for Calendar Year 2017. These are available on a first come, first served basis. The customary offering is \$60 per month. Please see Father Alaa for availability and to ensure reserving these memorials for specific dates or occasions.

**Daughters of St. Ann:** If you have not yet done so, please see Georgette Hannoush or Mrs. Patti Thornton to submit your 2017 dues.

**Lenten Regulations:** All Maronites who are physically capable are to abstain from meat on Ash Monday (February 27) and all Fridays of Lent.

Ash Monday and the Great Friday of the Crucifixion are also days of fasting. Fasting in the Maronite Church involves eating and drinking nothing at all (except water and medicine) from midnight until noon. The rest of the day normal meals can be taken but without meat. All Maronites who are physically capable are to fast on these two days.

**Devotion of Lenten Fridays:** Please join us at 6:30 pm on Fridays throughout Lent for Benediction with the Cross and Stations of the Cross.

**Reminder:** When you bring refreshments to share, please remember to clean up afterwards. Thank you for helping to maintain cleanliness in the House of God.

- + BAPTISM & CHRISMATION: Preparation is required. We encourage this to begin at least one month before the Baptism.
- + MARRIAGES: Arrangements six (6) months in advance.
- + NEW PARISHIONERS: Welcome to our parish family. May you find spiritual nourishment among our community. Please be sure to register with our parish by calling the Parish House.


