MARONITE LITURGY

Fraction, Signing, Sprinkling, Mingling, and Elevation

These five actions constitute one ritual, which may be called "the mystery of mysteries". Collectively, they aim to express the death of the Lord on the Cross, His burial, presentation to the Father, resurrection and ascension to heaven. Each of these actions has its own characteristic and meaning.

The Fraction of the Host - symbolizes our Lord's crucifixion and death;

Signing the chalice with part of the Host - the consecration of His life giving Blood;

Sprinkling the Body with Blood by immersion - the gift of life symbolized by the Blood;

Mingling the Consecrated Host in the Wine - uniting the Body and Blood;

Elevation of the Body and Blood - the Lord's resurrection and ascension into heaven, completing the mystery of redemption.


