MARONITE HISTORY

The Alleged Conversion of the Maronites

In 681AD, the sixth Ecumenical Council of Constantinople condemned the heresy of monothelitism. For a church or a community of believers to be guilty of heresy, it must make the erroneous teaching a public position of their church. It must be taught by their patriarch and bishops.

To be guilty of formal heresy in the Catholic Church, one must be officially condemned by the Church and persist in the erroneous teaching, once condemned. There is no indication that the Maronites, as a church, ever taught monothelitism. Some authors have tried to point to one or more personal writings of individual Maronites. But nowhere is there a false teaching attributed to a Maronite patriarch or bishop. Furthermore, the Council of Constantinople in condemning monothelitism, listed by name those who had spread this heresy. The Maronite Church is not mentioned nor is there a Maronite name on the list.

Regarding the claims of William of Tyre of a miraculous conversion of the Maronites, some Maronite scholars have speculated that the event might have been in actuality a public profession of faith rather than an abjuration of heresy. Through the years opponents of the Maronites have repeated the charge of heresy for their own purposes. It is unfortunate that various encyclopedias have perpetuated this unsubstantiated charge and not consulted the officials of the Maronite Church. On the other hand, for the last nine hundred years the Popes, in official declarations, have consistently praised the Maronites for their perpetual union with the Church of Rome.


