- + The Sign of Peace begins at the altar and is carried to the congregants by peace bearers.
- + Communion is by intinction and on the tongue. There is no communion in the hand.

Epiphany Water

If anyone was unable to celebrate Epiphany, and wishes to receive holy water, there will be blessed water available at Church, on Saturday.

Religious Education

The feast of Epiphany provided an opportunity for the children to learn about sacramentals. The Church, both East and West, has a custom of blessing homes on the Feast of the Epiphany. Family and friends gather to ask God's blessing on their homes and those who live in or visit the home. One way of doing this is with chalk, blessed by the priest. The following message is written above the entryway: "20+C+B+M+19". The children made Power Packs for 3 sacramentals to be used to bless their homes. Water to sprinkle inside, chalk to mark the exterior and blessed salt. Among early Christians, the savoring of blessed salt often took place along with baptism. In the fourth century, Augustine of Hippo named these practices "visible forms of invisible grace". Salt may be sprinkled in a room, or across a threshold, or in other places as an invocation of divine protection.

Pastoral Instruction


- **+ BAPTISM & CHRISMATION:** Preparation is required. We encourage this to begin at least one month before the Baptism.

- **+ DEVOTIONS:** Rosary on every Sunday at 9:00 AM before the Divine Liturgy.
