Some differences you may notice

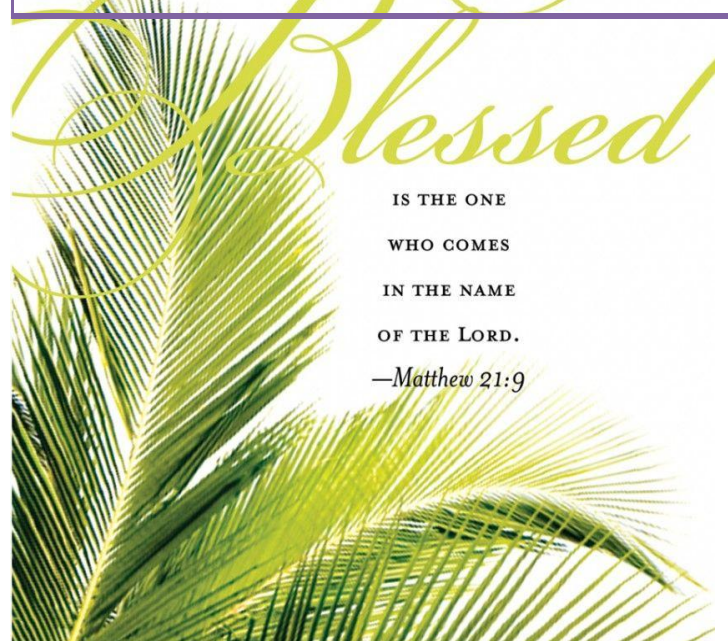
- + The Entrance dialog and Consecration are in Syriac Aramaic, the language of Jesus, Mary and the Apostles.
 - + The Sign of Peace begins at the altar and is carried to the congregants by peace bearers.
 - + Communion is by intinction and on the tongue. There is no communion in the hand.

QURBONO The Book of Offering

THE STRUCTURE OF THE NEW MARONITE QURBONO

The Internal Order **Qadeeshat Aloho**

This is the hymn of the Trisagion that is common to all rites in the *Qurbono* and other liturgical rites. In the Byzantine and Eastern Syriac Churches, this hymn is addressed to the Holy Trinity. However, in the Western Syriac Churches, including the Maronite Church, and in the Armenian, Coptic and Ethiopian Churches, this same hymn is addressed to the Lord Jesus alone. The Latin Church, theologically speaking, considers this hymn as Trinitarian; however, liturgically, that is, in the rite of adoration of the cross on Great Friday, it addresses this hymn to the Lord Jesus himself. A time honored tradition tells that Joseph of Arimathea was the first to recite this hymn at the feet of Christ when he removed him from the cross and buried him. The common response to the *Qadeeshat Aloho* is "Have mercy on us". However, on the great feasts and during the liturgical season that follows, proper verses are added to this response, such as: "who is born from the daughter of David...Have mercy on us" (Birth of the Lord), "who was baptized by John...Have mercy on us" (Epiphany), "who was crucified for us...Have mercy on us" (Passion Week), "who rose from the dead...Have mercy on us" (Resurrection)...*continued*
