Thank you for worshipping with us today. We are blessed by your presence. The Maronite Church is one of 21 Eastern Catholic Churches in full communion with Rome. The Maronite Church dates back to the early Christians of Antioch where "they were called Christians for the first time" (Acts 11:26)

Some differences you may notice

- + The Entrance dialog and Consecration are in Syriac Aramaic, the language of Jesus, Mary and the Apostles.
 - + The Sign of Peace begins at the altar and is carried to the congregants by peace bearers.
 - + Communion is by intinction and on the tongue. There is no communion in the hand.
- We hope and pray your experience is spiritually enriching.

The Internal Order **The Procession of the Gospel**

Before the proclamation of the Gospel, a procession takes place inside the sanctuary in honor of the Word of God. In earlier times, according to Patriarch Duwaih, this procession used to be performed in the midst of the congregation. However, we limited it here to the sanctuary. It starts from and returns to the place where the *Book of Gospels* is kept, preserving the rite of procession, on the one hand, and shortening the liturgical celebration, on the other. In addition, we have retained the burning of incense before the Gospel, in honor of the Word of God and also as an invitation for the congregation to stand. The warnings of the deacon, such as, "Remain silent...", provide the congregation with a favorable religious atmosphere.
