THE STRUCTURE OF THE NEW MARONITE QURBONO

The Internal Order PreAnaphora and Creed

The Pre-Anaphora is composed of a group of actions and prayers linking the first and second parts of the liturgy. Anaphora is a Greek term meaning "the offering of the *Qurbono*". This part begins with the Creed and includes the processional transfer of the gifts, their offering at the altar, and the incensation of the altar, gifts, and people. The Nicene-Constantinople Creed is currently used in the Maronite Church. It was introduced in the Service of the *Qurbono* during the fifth century. Formerly, it was considered as the testimony of the catechumens, made before they were admitted to the Mystery of Baptism; later on, it became the profession of faith of the baptized faithful before the Eucharist, once the catechumens were dismissed from the church.
